Job Description

An exciting opportunity has arisen for an enthusiastic, proactive and knowledgeable individual to take on the role as Head Physiotherapist at Rouen Normandie Rugby Club. The successful candidate will head up the physiotherapy for the full-time first team squad and will work along side our multi-disciplinary team of 2 technical coaches, a director of sport, 4 strength and conditioning coaches and a performance analyst, as well as liaising with other part-time French medical staff, including club doctors and physios. Your job will entail covering all 1st team training and fixtures, home and away and other duties will include:

- To manage the first team medical department to ensure the highest level of function and development is continued
- To provide highly accurate assessment and effective treatment ensuring a timely yet comprehensive return to pre-injury state for all first team players
- To lead on all pre-signing medical screenings for prospective first team players
- To promptly communicate all relevant medical information and provide updates on injured first team players to the head coach
- To refer players for appropriate diagnostic imaging and specialist consultations and interventions where appropriate
- To liaise with appropriate medical specialists to ensure prompt referral; building a strong network of contacts and develop strong working relationships
- To manage and oversee all medical staff within the first team
- To provide pitch side first aid for first team training as well as evening and weekend matches both home and away. This will include the implementation of Emergency Action Plans (EAP)
- Provide pre training strapping for players where appropriate

- To travel with the team to all fixtures, this will include overnight stays where necessary.
- To collate all medical information and that all medical documents are recorded and maintained
- To ensure that all medical equipment is fully functional and that stock levels of medical supplies are maintained
- To oversee and contribute to the continuous professional development of all sports science department.
- To oversee and ensure regular and appropriate medical screening is undertaken including concussion and physical profiling.
